1. The HALF YEARLY EXAMINATION for the academic year 2021-22 will be conducted from 12th September to 21st September 2021 in the form of online tests due to the prevailing pandemic.
2. Timetable of the examinations specifying the dates have already been sent to you in the Google Classroom.
3. The Half Yearly Examinations for classes I and II will be conducted only using Google Forms including a variety of questions.
4. All the questions are compulsory and need to be attempted. Every student will be allowed only one attempt per test. There will be no retests.
5. In case of power failure or network dis-connectivity, kindly ensure that you are informing the class teacher immediately. Any delay in the same will not be considered.
6. In the previous examinations, we have categorically observed that children attempting the examination through the mobile phones have faced problems in accessing the google forms. It is our request that, for the examination days kindly try to arrange a computer/laptop for your child to ensure a hassle-free exam.
7. Students should login to their respective Class Teacher's Google Classroom 15 MINUTES prior to the examination time.
8. Link for the exam will be posted in the chat box by the teacher at the beginning of the examination time.
9. Please ensure that your child is not logging in with his or her sibling or parent id into the examination classroom. Also when your ward is opening the Google Form link posted by the teacher, please verify and ensure that the email id used is his/her own id (The email id will be displayed on the top of the first page of the form). If the email id is different, there is an option (switch account) to edit and correct the same there itself without logging out. It is mandatory to follow this step because if a child attempts the paper with a wrong email id, he/she will be marked absent for the particular exam.



10. Students are instructed to submit the forms within the given time frame as no form will be accepted by the system after the said time. Parents to kindly ensure that the system has a proper battery backup.
11. It is mandatory to have your audio muted and camera turned on during the examination. Tests attempted with the cameras turned off will be considered invalid.
12. Parents should try to find a quiet and suitable place for the child to attempt the exams and should ensure that no study material is available near the child.
13. Once all the questions have been attempted, students must review all their answers before submission. Then they should click the **SUBMIT** button on the form.
14. The portion and examination timetable have been sent to you via Google Classroom.
15. In order to make the children familiar with the concept of online test, practice tests have already been conducted and further revision tests will be done during the class hours.
16. The students are expected to be honest and sincere in their endeavor to attempt the tests.
17. The examination will be monitored by the invigilators.
18. The examination will be recorded.
19. Students are expected to wear decent attire for the examination.
20. Any student found to be using unfair means will not be awarded any marks in the particular paper. Result of the student will also be withheld.
21. There will not be a retest under any circumstance.
